SPICES - Learning Objectives

Emotional - Understand that everybody is unique and important

Social - Explore how people communicate

Social - Be a friend. Understand that everyone is different. Be welcoming and include others in the things I do.

Overview

- In a large group, each person is handed a bingo page filled with attributes or statements that could apply to different people e.g. interests, hobbies, family, etc.
- Participants move around looking for people who match the attributes or statements.
- The activity enables participants to get to know other members of the group.

Activity Objectives

- Learn about other members of the group
- Have fun

Materials

- · Bingo sheets
- Pens

Description

- Give out a bingo sheet and a pen to each person
- Everyone walks around the room and tries find a person that matches a statement in a box.
- When they find someone, write their name in the relevant box.
- Every box should have a different name.
- First person to complete their sheet, shouts bingo
- At the end read out each statement to see how many of the members it applies to.

• Adjust the statements for each age group but also have statements that suit your own group.

- Did you enjoy the activity?
- Did you find out something about members you didn't know?
