Rover Chief Scout Award - Tracker Card

The Rover Scout may commence the award in the first year in the section. Only challenges/elements which are completed **AFTER** a Rover Scout is registered for the award can be counted towards it.

A minimum of 18 months duration. 12 months if Venture CSA holder.

Portfolio: A written record of the work completed for all the elements of the award.



Skill: One Special Interest Project from the **Skill** area.



Physical: One Special Interest Project in the **Physical** area.



Community: One Special Interest Project from the **Community** area.



Environment: One Special Interest Project from the **Environment** area - with a time commitment of at least 16 hours overall.

Note: A Special Interest Project for the Rover Chief Scout Award must involve at least an hour a week for 52 Weeks for Skill, Physical and Community. For those that do not hold a Venture Chief Scout Award an extra 26 weeks must be completed for 1 of these badges.
