



## Scout Chief Scout Award

A Scout should be in their final year in the Section and must be at least 14 to begin the award.

Only challenges/elements which are completed **AFTER** a Youth Member is registered for the award can be counted towards it.

**A minimum of 6 months duration.**

**Special Interest Badges** as follows:



**Skill:** One Special Interest project from the **Skill** area.



**Physical:** One Special Interest project in the **Physical** area.



**Community:** One Special Interest project from the **Community** area.



**Environment:** One Special Interest project from the **Environment** area with a time commitment of at least 8 hours overall. A support to achieving this may be the World Scout Environmental Badge.

Note: A Special Interest project for the Scout Chief Scout Award must involve at least 1 hour a week for 13 Weeks for Skill, Physical & Community. An additional 13 weeks is required for 1 of these 3 Special Interest badges.



Two **Adventure Skills** to Stage 4. One Adventure Skill to Stage 5.

**Expedition:** Walking 25 to 35km over 2 consecutive days and 1 night.

Other challenging expedition types such as water-based or cycling can also be undertaken - prior approval is required from [csa.support@scouts.ie](mailto:csa.support@scouts.ie)

**Intercultural:** Shared activity with a group in a residential/camp setting for 2 days and 1 night and find out about different cultures.
